New Aviation History Display at Middleton Airport

Middleton, WI. (March 28, 2005) – A Wisconsin aviation history display has been established at the Middleton Municipal Airport - Morey Field (C29) by the Wisconsin Aviation Hall of Fame.

The display case features the history and memorabilia of North Central Airlines; a Wisconsin-based airline that eventually became Republic and then Northwest Airlines. Also included is information and memorabilia regarding Robert Reeve, a Waunakee, Wisconsin native who founded Reeve Aleutian Airways in Alaska.

Aviation enthusiasts are encouraged to visit the airport to view the display. Display items will be changed on a continuing basis.

The mission statement of the Wisconsin Aviation Hall of Fame is to collect and preserve the aviation history in Wisconsin, recognize those who made that history, inform others of it, and promote aviation education to future generations. The organization was founded in 1985.
